

Waynesburg Central Band Booster Meeting Minutes

July 5, 2023

The meeting was held in the WCJSHS Choir Room, and called to order by Randy Pettit at 7:02pm. Attendance was recorded.

Secretary's Report: Those in attendance reviewed the June 2023 meeting minutes. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Kari Fox and seconded by Jason Whipkey . Motion carried.

2023/24 Planning:

1. Committee Reports – Student Events:

- a. Band Camp Committee: Mr. Mason explained that Summer band practice starts for 2 weeks on July 17th at WCJSHS. Anyone involved in the half-time show will attend for the duration from 4pm – 9:30pm, including an hour dinner break from 5:30pm – 6:30pm. Seventh grade students will attend from 6:30-8:30pm. Away Band Camp is at California University from July 30th – August 4th for half-time show students, but 7th graders will attend Band Camp from July 30th – August 2nd. Registration will be between 5-6pm on July 30th, departure will be between 5-6pm on August 4th. Students must eat dinner before they arrive. Any 7th grader wishing to spend the the additional days there, are permitted to do so, but then they will pay the full registration fee/raffle tickets of \$400. Chaperones must stay after this meeting to speak with Mr. Mason. Students will stay in dorms, 2 students per room. Doors will not be closed. Separate floors will be available for males and females and chaperones will be on each floor. Each dorm room has a bathroom. If you are interested in being a chaperone, start by making sure you have your clearances and are approved by the school board. A packet will be provided with a packing list. Marching band shoes should be purchased prior to away band camp, if possible, and a link is available under “Resources” on the band website.

- a. Fundraising Committee:
 - i. Registration/Raffle Tickets: We have a large number of students who have either not paid registration or picked up raffle tickets. The deadline is July 17th. If your student is not attending band camp, but participating in Summer band, they are still expected to pick up raffle tickets or pay the registration. Thus far, we have collected \$8000 for registration.
 - ii. T-shirt sponsors: Tonight, we just received sufficient sponsorships to meet our t-shirt sponsorship goal of \$3000. Any last minute sponsorships should be sent to Janelle Wise, ASAP.

- iii. Sodexo: Dates posted on WC Band Parents Facebook page. Please contact Jill Barnhart if interested. Sodexo is a way to make money for your student's account.
 - iv. Golf Tournament : The Golf Outing was a success. We earned \$7782.00, exceeding the goal of \$5000.
 - v. Upcoming Student Account Fundraising will be considered this Summer by our new chair, Kim Price.
 - b. Concessions: Tina will be providing a request list for items to be donated during Summer Band. Melissa or Tina will be providing a sign up list for parents to work football games – a parent/guardian/family member is asked to work at least one football game in the stand per season.
 - c. Uniform: There is a link on the website for purchasing marching band shoes.
