

## Waynesburg Central Band Booster Meeting Minutes

June 7, 2023

The meeting was held in the WCJSHS Choir Room, and called to order by Jeremy Rohanna at 7:07pm. Attendance was recorded.

**Correspondence:** Sponsorships were received from Iron Senergy, First Federal, Moose Lodge, VFW, and Kalsey Insurance for the Golf Outing.

**Secretary's Report:** Those in attendance reviewed the May 2023 meeting minutes. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Randy Pettit and seconded by Barbara Herrington. Motion carried.

**Treasurer's Report:** A Treasurer's report was provided by Janelle Wise. Janelle explained the different types of funds or the new 7<sup>th</sup> grade parents. The three accounts need to have Kevin Maxewll come into First Federal and sign existing cards for the accounts. Account balances as follows:

1. Committee Reports – Student Events:
  - a. Band Camp Committee: Mr. Mason explained that the Away Band Camp is at California University this Summer. There may not be a swimming pool available that week. Students will stay in dorms, 2 students per room. Doors will not be closed. Separate wings will be available for males and females. Each dorm has a bathroom. If you are interested in being a chaperone, start by making sure you have your clearances and are approved by the school board.

2. Committee Reports – Booster-Led Events:
  - a. Fundraising Committee:

    - iii. Golf Tournament : We have 12 teams, but we need 18 teams. Please ask friends, businesses, etc. to participate as a team (\$300) or a sponsor. We have donations from First Federal, GenMar, Community Bank, Iron senergy, Waynesburg Animal Hospital, Fox Ford, JD Enterprise, Sheetz, ARS, Camco, Brady's Roadhouse, Lori Greene, Todd Moore, Direct Results, Moose Lodge. Our prizes are the E-bike, Pirate suite, 3 skill prizes. Casa Capri and Rohanna Family are donating lunch. We need workers for this event on June 17<sup>th</sup>: Set-up

night before, registration 7am – 9am, Chinese Auction 7am-9am, 50/50 Help 7am – 11am, Hole Prize Help, Hot Dog sales at the turn (could be students), Drinks (could be students), Assisting with Lunch.

  - b. Concessions: Sign ups to work concession stand will start in July. Water bottle donations will be requested. We are considering what else we may use as donated for the upcoming year (Melissa will discuss with committee chair, Tina Huffman).
