

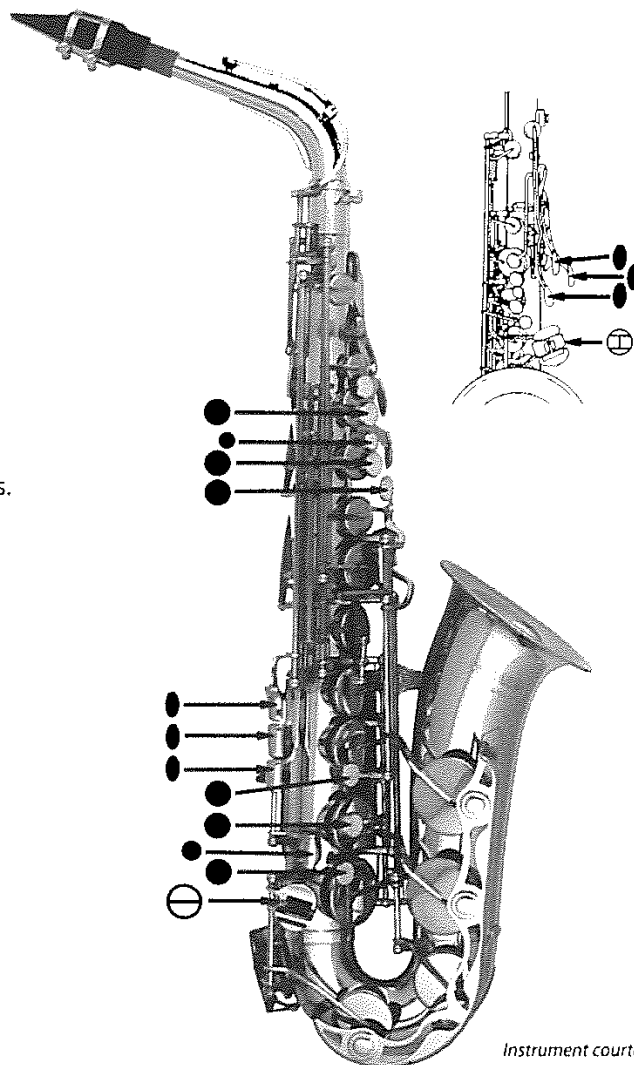
# FINGERING CHART

### Instrument Care Reminders

Before putting your instrument back in its case after playing, do the following:

- Remove the reed, wipe off excess moisture.
- Remove the mouthpiece and wipe the inside with a clean cloth.
- Place reed back onto mouthpiece.
- Remove the neck and shake out excess moisture. Dry with a rolled up paper towel.
- Drop the weight of the chamois or cotton swab into the bell. Pull the swab through the body several times. Return the instrument to its case.
- Your case is designed to hold only specific objects. If you try to force anything else into the case, it may damage your instrument.

- = Pressed down

The most common fingering appears first when two fingerings are shown.
