

Waynesburg Central Band Booster Meeting Minutes

August 3, 2022

The meeting was held in a WCHS classroom and called to order by Jeremy Rohanna at 7:00pm. A “zoom” option for the meeting was available. Attendance was recorded.

Secretary’s Report: Those in attendance reviewed the July 2022 meeting minutes. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Janelle Wise and seconded by Tim Moore. Motion carried.

Treasurer’s Report: And MBM Treasurer’s report was provided and distributed. There was no formal WCHS Treasurer’s report due to a computer problem. The following balances were verbally communicated by Janelle Wise:

General Fund: \$20,730

Concession Fund: \$2000

Student Fund: \$8166

Golf Tournament Fundraiser Report: The first annual Band Booster Golf Outing was held on July 30, 2022. Jeremy thanked all of the volunteers who helped with the event or obtained sponsors. The estimated profit from the event is \$5000. Casa Capri donated lunch, and Jeremy asked that anyone who goes to Casa Capri to thank them for this donation.

Upcoming 2022/23 Planning:

1. Uniform Washing: Bags of uniforms are available for anyone who can take them home to wash.
2. Concession Stand: Melissa Kirsch asked that every parent/guardian sign up for 1 night of working the concession stand for our 5 home football games. A sign up list was available at the meeting. Volunteers are asked to bring one case of bottled water when they work the concession stand. A meeting was also held with the Soccer Boosters, and the Soccer Boosters will be purchasing soda to sell in the concession stand from the Band Boosters.
3. Senior Night: Jill Barnhart volunteered to work with the senior parents on plans for Senior Night.
4. Band Banquet: It was decided that we will just hold a band banquet in May for band students, likely at the Lions Club Park. A committee will be needed in the future to plan this event.
5. Summer Band Camp: Band camp will start on Sunday, August 7th, registration at 1pm. Chaperones are asked to arrive by noon. A nurse is always present. Cabins are air conditioned. Uniforms will be brought to band camp for pictures the first night.
6. Fundraisers: Additional fundraising ideas were presented. Lindsay Parks provided an overview of a new fundraising opportunity through Canonsburg Cake Company. Band Boosters will try to organize 1 fundraiser per month for student accounts. The following fundraisers will be held in the Fall, and coordinators were selected as listed:
 - a. September: Canonsburg Cake Co. Cupcakes – Janelle Wise
 - b. October: Pepperoni Rolls – Randy Pettit

- c. November: Hilltop Coffee – Jeremy Rohanna
 - d. Future: Applelicious Apples – Kari Fox (possibly January fundraiser)
 - e. The following additional fundraisers will be considered for 2023: Pittsburgh Popcorn, Candy Bars, and possibly a second Pepperoni Roll fundraiser
 - f. Sodexo work at WVU is available as well. Janelle will serve as coordinator.
7. Sodexo opportunities to fundraise for student accounts continue through the Summer with Black Bears games. For information, Jill Barnhart should be contacted. Jill mentioned that the WC Band Boosters should look into whether the Sodexo insurance needs to be renewed and also to find a new Sodexo coordinator on behalf of the Boosters.
 8. The WCHS Football schedule was provided, and is available on the CGSD website. Students will report at 5:45pm for most home games, and are expected to stay till the end of the game, and march back to the band rooms.

Mr. Mason’s Report:

When we return from band camp, band practice for the field show students will be held Tuesdays and Thursdays from 5:30-7:30pm until school starts. Once school starts, field show students will practice on the same days from 3:30 – 5pm. MBM students will ride a bus from MBM, and practice on Thursdays after school from 3:30-5pm. MBM students will practice during school certain days during SSR period in the morning.

Mr. Mason also gave a general overview of Band Camp logistics, packing, etc., all of which is provided in the Band packet.

The Liberty High School Band Spectacular in Clarksburg, WV will be September 17th (Field Show only).

The Buckwheat Festival Parade is September 29th.

The California University Homecoming Parade will be October 8th.

MBM marching band will participate in the following parades: Halloween, Veterans, Christmas.
Buckwheat Parade is still under evaluation.
