

## Waynesburg Central Band Booster Meeting Minutes

November 2, 2022

The meeting was held in the WCHS band room and called to order by Jeremy Rohanna at 7:01pm. A “zoom” option for the meeting was available. Attendance was recorded.

**Secretary’s Report:** Those in attendance reviewed the October 2022 meeting minutes. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Erin Gump and seconded by Susan Hoge. Motion carried.

**Treasurer’s Report:** A WCHS Treasurer’s Report was prepared by Janelle Wise and read by Doug Mason in her absence. Concession stand is estimated to have profited about \$6000 this season, which is about \$1000 more than budgeted. We made approximately \$180 from FanWear, \$1000 from the Penn West (California) Homecoming Parade, and \$224 from the Buckwheat Parade. Kevin Maxwell read the MBM student account treasurer’s report.

### 2022/23 Planning:

1. Concession Stand: Thanks to all those who helped in the concession stand this year. A special thanks to Tina Huffman for ordering and preparing almost all of the food, John Kirsch for working 4 of the 5 nights, and Jill Barnhart for procuring and donating soft pretzels. We had a couple of parents work multiple games (Erin Gump and Brandy Talpas), and we really appreciate their help.
2. Spring Trip Proposals: No news at this time.
3. Fundraisers: We have individual fundraisers scheduled (below):
  - a. General Fund Fundraiser: Raffle tickets (Money & Guns raffle). We have about half the tickets “out”, but not a lot returned with money yet. Tickets are still available and we really need volunteers to sell tickets
  - b. October: Pepperoni Rolls – Chico Bakery will delivery Pepperoni Rolls on November 10<sup>th</sup>, morning, and will be distributed to students that Thursday during practice.
  - c. November: Hilltop Coffee Fundraiser order forms distributed. Must be returned by November 30<sup>th</sup>. This fundraiser is for the individual accounts.
  - d. Sodexo: WVU basketball games available for volunteers to work in November to earn money for individual accounts. Randy Pettit read the dates from an email from Jill Barnhart. Anyone interested should contact Jill directly.
  - e. Future: Apples are still planned for February/March 2023.
  - f. The following additional fundraisers will be considered for 2023: Pittsburgh Popcorn, Candy Bars, and possibly a second Pepperoni Roll fundraiser
  - g. Night at the Races: We are still considering this as a Spring event, VFW will not charge anything to use the venue, but will sell alcohol.
  - h. Golf Tournament: Jeremy is working on dates, tentatively June 17<sup>th</sup>.

### Mr. Mason’s Report:

Concert Attire: Students have been measured that need concert attire. Mr. Mason will be ordering concert attire tomorrow.

December 9<sup>th</sup>: Christmas Concert at 7pm, students arrive at 5:59pm.

December 10<sup>th</sup>: Mt. Morris Christmas Parade, timing to be announced.
