 - a. Small Game of Chance: Softball has a license, and we are able to use it.
- 5. New Business
 - The Christmas Parade (Waynesburg) Dec. 2nd: Mr. Maxwell will try to coordinate using the Presbyterian Church in Waynesburg for student drop-off. It is a long parade. There will be parade practice after school on Thursday, Nov. 16th, and Nov. 30th.
 - b. The Mt. Morris Christmas Parade: Dec. 9th, and it's a short parade. Both parades are required.
 - c. The Winter Concert is Friday, December 8th at WCJSHS. The 5th and 6th grade bands will be joining us for a song. Concert Attire for 9th-12th graders are tuxes and gowns. Parents are responsible for paying for their child's apparel, \$68-72 is the cost. Boosters may have to purchase 4-5 more jackets. If someone is in desperate need for the tux/gown, please contact Mr. Mason. The 7th/8th graders should wear all black, try to avoid leggings. Wear black shoes. Dec. 7th practice will be 9th-12th grade, and Dec. 5th will be 7th-8th grade, after school till 5pm. It's possible that on Dec. 6th they may perform at WCES during the school day.
 - d. Mr. Mason is working on small ensembles for 7th-12th grades, like jazz band. We have several students who are interested. Next Wednesday, Mr. Mason has a meeting with GCMEA to see if we can get the other schools involved. We are trying to expand these to elementary school, more for educational purposes.
 - e. Trailer/Performance discussion from last meeting: The cost of the trailer was more expensive than the person who wanted the performance wanted to pay, so this is tabled for now.
