

Waynesburg Central Band Booster Meeting Minutes

September 7, 2022

The meeting was held in the WCHS band room and called to order by Jeremy Rohanna at 6:39pm. A “zoom” option for the meeting was available. Attendance was recorded.

Secretary’s Report: Those in attendance reviewed the August 2022 meeting minutes. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Kevin Maxwell and seconded by Chisty Barto. Motion carried.

Treasurer’s Report: A WCHS Treasurer’s Report was provided by Janelle Wise. There are not sufficient funds available in the General Fund account to cover Summer band camp expenses. Outstanding band fees need to be turned in as soon as possible. Janelle is looking into outstanding sponsorship checks. An MBM Treasurer’s Report was provided by Kevin Maxwell.

A motion to transfer money from the student accounts to the general fund to cover current expenses and then reimburse the students accounts with future fundraisers was made by Christy Barto and seconded by Janelle Wise. Motion carried.

Upcoming 2022/23 Planning:

1. Uniform Washing: Tina Huffman, Jeremy Rohanna, Kevin Maxwell, and Melissa Kirsch volunteered to wash the remaining white jackets.
2. Concession Stand: Christy Barto will donate snacks for the next game for the visiting band. The concession stand has made a good profit the past 2 games, but workers are needed for every home football game. Every parent/guardian is expected to work the concession stand at least one game per season. This is an important fundraiser for our band.
3. Senior Night: Jill Barnhart volunteered to work with the senior parents on plans for Senior Night. We buy posters of each senior, \$35 each, \$18 each for flowers. We have 5 seniors, so approximately a \$300 spend. Janelle Wise will order the posters. Alissa Fox has volunteered to purchase senior flowers and bring them to the game.
4. Band Banquet: This will be addressed later.
5. Fundraisers: We have individual fundraisers scheduled (below). We need to start a General Fund fundraiser. Additional fundraising ideas were presented. Janelle will call Night at the Races and Jeremy will call Armory. Jeremy will contact AD to see if we can sell Vera Bradley bags at Football games. The following fundraisers will be held in the Fall, and coordinators were selected as listed:
 - a. September: Canonsburg Cake Co. Cupcakes – fundraiser delayed because of lack of profitability for student accounts (profit is only 16% of sales).
 - b. October: Pepperoni Rolls – Randy Pettit
 - c. November: Hilltop Coffee – Jeremy Rohanna
 - d. Fanware: Link should be available by end of week. We will email it, send it via remind, and post on Facebook pages.
 - e. Future: Applelicious Apples – Kari Fox (possibly January fundraiser)

- f. The following additional fundraisers will be considered for 2023: Pittsburgh Popcorn, Candy Bars, and possibly a second Pepperoni Roll fundraiser
 - g. Sodexo opportunities are available to fundraise for student accounts continue through the Fall at WVU football games. For information, Jill Barnhart or Janelle should be contacted.
6. The WCHS Football schedule was provided, and is available on the CGSD website. Students will report at 5:45pm for most home games, and are expected to stay till the end of the game, and march back to the band rooms.
