



WCHS Raider Band Boosters Meeting Minutes

June 17, 2020

The meeting was called to order at 7:29 pm by President Kevin McElheny. The meeting being held in a pavilion at the Lion's Club Park. Social distancing and masks were encouraged.

1. December 2019, and March 2020 minutes were provided. No questions, comments or changes were discussed. A motion was made by Mary Redman, second by Stacey Wheaton to pass both sets of minutes. There were no objections, the minutes were passed.
2. The Treasurer's report was provided by Michelle Barnes. The refund check from Kaleidoscope has been deposited into the bank. It will be available to distribute on June 18, 2020. The current bills that are due are USPS \$64.00 for the PO Box (1 year) and WCHS's half of the website payment \$66.11 (1 year). Renee Biagini made a motion to pay these two bills, and accept the treasurer's report. Mary Redman second it. All were in favor; the 2 bills will be paid. Each person that paid for the trip will be losing \$88.06. This is \$61.94 dollars less than what the registration papers say is non-refundable. Checks will be written soon, and Mr. Mason will set up a date/time for parents to pick up their checks if they have requested their money back.
3. Election of Officers. Stacey Wheaton reported that the only person who had submitted that they were interested in a position was Jennifer Gumbarevic, for Secretary again. All board members, Kevin McElheny(President), Stacey Wheaton(Vice President), Jennifer Gumbarevic(Secretary) and Michell Barnes(Treasurer) all agreed to run again for their board positions. Nominations were called for from the floor, with no response. It was agreed upon that a verbal vote would take place. All were in favor of re-electing the current board into their positions. There were no objections. Board members will remain the same for the 2020-2021 season.
4. A budget was provided by Mr. Mason. Sandy Gatten made a motion to pass the budget, and Kevin Maxwell second it. There were no objections, and the budget for the 2020-2021 season was passed.
5. Fundraising: We will need to reschedule the Vera Bradley bingo as soon as we can. Sarris candy will again be sold this year for both Christmas and Easter. Melissa Cramer will be in charge of this fundraiser again with Debbie Heisey her co-chair. Dates will be determined for the sales dates, turn ins and pickups. Jackson's Mills is currently closed. We are unsure if we will be able to use the Pepperoni Rolls for a fundraiser this year or not. If anyone has suggestions for new fundraisers this year please let a board member know.



6. Mr. Mason: We are to proceed with normal routines. Adjustments will be made as needed. Our band fees will be exactly as they were last year. It will be determined when they will be due as we learn new procedures from the school district.
7. This year's schedule has been provided. Renee Biagini motioned to approve the schedule and Kevin Maxwell second it. All were in favor of this year's schedule, it was passed.
8. Parents who will be volunteers will need to have their clearances done. If their clearances are still good, please contact Barb Moore at the Administration building to be sure that your name is submitted for the 2020-2021 season. Your name must be as it is listed on your driver's license.
9. New Business: Band will start on July 20, 2020. Percussion will start on July 15, 2020. The home band schedule will be the same: 3:00 pm – 9:00 pm, Monday through Friday. Band Camp is yet to be determined. We are still looking at options. We are unsure if we will be able have over night camps. 6<sup>th</sup> grade band is to be determined if they will be part of the MBM unit or not. Anyone with concerns should contact the Superintendent and include Mr. Matt Blair. There will be a Zoom meeting for all students and parents soon so that everyone gets the same information at the same time. Mr. Mason will hold this meeting after he gets direction from the school district. We must receive direction and verification from the district before we can proceed.
