



WCHS Raider Band Boosters Meeting Minutes

July 15, 2020

The meeting was called to order at 7:35 pm by President Kevin McElheny. The meeting being held in a pavilion at the Lion's Club Park. Social distancing and masks were encouraged.

1. June 2020 minutes were provided. No questions, comments or changes were discussed. A motion was made by Brenda Boutin, second by Mary Redman to pass both sets of minutes. There were no objections, the minutes were passed.
2. The Treasurer's report was not provided due to a family emergency in Michelle Barnes' family. Almost all of checks have been given back to parents/guardians for the trip refund. The few that are left will be distributed as soon as possible.
3. The insurance policy is up for renewal. The amount is \$750.00. Jill Barnhardt suggested, that with the current Covid situation, and the cancellation of games, or the possibility of low attendance, we should consider taking a year off of Sodexo fundraising. Jill made a motion for this. Mr. Desrosiers second it. All were in favor, it was passed.
4. Summer Band Camp will not start on July 20, 2020 but on July 21, 2020. It will be from 4:00 pm – 7:00 pm. Students are to bring and wear when applicable masks. They are to bring their own labeled water bottles/snacks. There will NOT be a dinner break. After the 2 weeks of band camp, it will be determined when rehearsals/practices will be. Students/Staff will enter through the Y door and have a Covid screening. They will proceed directly to their sections. Restrooms will be available by the band room and will be accessed one at a time. There will be no use of water fountains. Nothing will be passed out.
5. T-Shirts: We will hold off on production of band t-shirts for the summer. We will do them during the school year at some point. We will at that time also have merchandise for sale for parents/public again.
6. Concession stand for this year will not open.
7. Picture day is TBD. They are impossible with social distancing.
8. Fundraising: The Vera Bradley Bingo has been rescheduled for September 26, 2020. A lot of help will be needed for this fundraiser. All other fundraisers are on hold for now except for Sarris Candy. If you can help in anyway with the Vera Bradley Bingo please contact Brenda Boutin or Sandy Gatten. There will be no food donated. A prepackaged meal of: 2 sliders, chips and a drink will be sold. Donations are needed for making baskets and for the auction baskets. Our capacity is down to 75 people we will be losing \$1000.00 in ticket sales along. Masks will be worn at anytime social distancing can't be done.
