



WCHS Raider Band Boosters Meeting Minutes

October 2, 2019

1. Meeting called to order at 7:32 pm by President Kevin McElheny
2. Approve September minutes.
  - a. Motion to pass the minutes by Stacey Wheaton, second by Sandy Gatten, all in favor.
  - b. Minutes passed.
3. Treasurer's report.
  - a. Trip account: \$17.31
  - b. Student Savings: \$10,044.60
  - c. Concessions: \$5113.44
  - d. Checking: \$11,227.90
  - e. All bills have been paid for. We received a bill from Baily Insurance for \$100.00 for adding MBM to the insurance. It will be discussed between the HS and MBM as to how much will be paid by MBM.
4. Concession Stand.
  - a. We have one last home game on October 18, 2019. This is Senior recognition night. Jennifer did not have the volunteer list however she thinks that there are plenty of parents signed up to help. Jennifer said that after having pizza in the concession stand twice, and a profit was made, that she does not think that pizza is worth the hassle. No pizza will be ordered for the last game. It is nice having it on the menu and she will think of other options.
5. T-shirts
  - a. We had 16 sponsors for our t-shirts this year. The cost of the shirts was: \$952.02. We have made \$190.00 on t-shirt sales at the home games and we made \$265.00 for the Fan Wear site online. We also have 1 sponsor for next year's shirts as Community Bank's sponsor came in after we printed this year's shirts.
6. Senior Night
  - a. Banners are done and been given to Mr. Olisar. The cost for 13 banners were \$442.00. Stacey cannot order flowers this early, she will order them a week before senior night.
7. Fundraising:
  - a. Fall booster raffle: Bridget Dennison was not at the meeting but gave us different amounts and profits for several different ticket sales for another Fredericktown Butcher Shop meat give away. Mary Redman made a motion to sell 500 tickets at \$10.00 a piece with 2 numbers on them. Michelle Barnes second the motion, all were in favor. Bridget will have the tickets printed and we will pass them out. Profit if all tickets are sold would be \$4000 after the give a way is paid for.

- b. Pepperoni Rolls: The sale went well. After a mix up on the Jackson's Mills side, we were able to get the Pepperoni Rolls for only \$1.00 a piece. We also received more than we had ordered for the concession stand. We will revisit a possible spring sale for the pepperoni rolls again.
- c. NYC shopping trip: There were no buses available at this time, if we want a fall trip we need to plan for it earlier in the year. A trip to Amish Country was mentioned Jennifer will call the companies again to see if that is possible and if they have a preset itinerary for the areas. Mary Redman said that Sugar Creek is the best area to visit. The dates would be for April 4, 18 or March 21 or 28.
- d. Sodexo: Jill needs workers for football games. WVU has back to back games coming up. If you would like to volunteer please contact Jill Barnhart. We have been offered to work the club section at this year's basketball games. There are 17 home games and we would need at least 15 volunteers for all the games. It was suggested that we guarantee we can get at least 5 people to each game, and we could share the club section with another group.
- e. Sarris: Orders are due at the beginning of the day on October 10, 2019. Delivery will be at our next booster meeting on November 6, 2019. Students can bring home their orders from school that day or they will be available for pick up at the meeting.
- f. FFA Fruit Sale: No information is available yet. Possibly in November.
- g. Future Student Fund Raisers: FFA Fruit Sale, Spring Sarris Candy, Spring Popcorn, Spring Pepperoni Rolls.
8. Banquet: The banquet will be held on Saturday, January 11, 2020 at 2:00 pm in the Waynesburg University dining hall. High School band boosters will pay for the high school band members and the Middle School band booster will pay for the middle school band members. Additional family members may attend the banquet for \$15.00 a person.
9. Upcoming schedule/meeting
  - a. Open House for the High School is October 3, 2019
  - b. Our last home game is on October 18, 2019. This is Senior Recognition Night. Parents are to arrive by 6:15 pm and meet at the 50 yard line on the far side of the field.   - c. Halloween Parade is on October 24, 2019 there is an early dismissal on that day for students.
  - d. Veteran's Day Parade will be on November 9, 2019.
