The Treasurer was absent, but Renee Biagini sent in her report to Kevin for booster approval. Renee stated that we have some big checks from Sudexo but they are not currently in the student accounts. ## **Old Business:**

1. Vera Bradley tickets need to be returned ASAP. We can sell the extra at the door.
  - a. Brenda needs to buy 6 more bags, she would like to have 900 bags. Bridgett Dennison has one bag she can donate for this.
  - b. There are 150 tickets
  - c. We need help with Baskets for the Vera Bradley

- d. Need 6 people to help. Front door, Chinese auction, and ticket sellers.
  - i. Teresa Allen, Kristi Barto, Melissa Cramer, Mark Cramer and Bridgett Dennison have volunteered to help with this.
- e. Doors open at 12 noon on 03/10/2018
- 2. The popcorn and Sarris sale ends on 02/16/2018. The pick-up date is 03/21/2018 at the high school band room.
- 3. Cash bash
  - a. Occurs April 21,2018 @ 4pm till 9pm
  - b. We need Volunteers to sign up for Cleanup, Setup, and to sell King Tut tickets.
  - c. We need to push the Hulk tickets
  - d. Renee sent a list of companies that she has contacted for donations for the baskets if anyone can please follow up with some of them
  - e. All unsold tickets to the cash bash must be turned in on April 1<sup>st</sup>, no exceptions. If you have tickets after that date you are responsible for paying for them.
  - f. Catering will be done through the Greene County CTC- Culinary Arts Program. Stacey is to get us a cost once Mr. Wagner meets with her. The food is included in the cost of the ticket, along with the beer. Wine is excluded.
    - i. Sandy Gatton has agreed to help work the kitchen.
  - g. We need cashiers also to handle the money.
  - h. We need alcohol bought for jello-shots if anyone would like to purchase this and donate it to the cause.
  - i. We need tickets for the cash bash- but we will not do light blue due to having them for something else and we do not want confusion.
  - j. The question was brought up if the Pride is wanting a percentage from the Cash bash and if so how much. This was to be given in writing, but we have not received anything as of this date. Bridgette will check with Renee, although we have another meeting at the end of March.
  - k. Chinese Auction- Melissa and Renee thought that the proceeds for this could be divided to those students attending band camp to help defer the cost.
- 4. Spring Competition
  - a. Every other year do something small.
  - b. This year we are doing PMEA Music Adjudication at Kiski Area High School and then going to Cleveland Zoo. This was picked by the seniors.
    - i. A copy of the itinerary has been passed out.
    - ii. We would like to have the forms back with the first payment on 02/20/18 of \$120. The Second payment of \$110 on 03/05/18 and the last payment on 03/26/18 of \$110.
    - iii. This is a state-wide concert bands of 25-30 bands.
    - iv. Kaleidoscope needs the first payment ASAP

- v. Then Kiski High School needs their payment.
- c. Norfolk maybe done every other year.

  - j. Set up a possible presentation at the next meeting 03/07/18
