

## WCHS Raider Band Booster Meeting Minutes

July 17, 2019

1. Called to order at 7:45pm by President Kevin McElheny
2. Approve May Minutes- Not available
3. Treasurer's Report- All bills are paid, we have \$17.31 in the trip account
4. Upcoming and Planning
  - a. Election of a New Treasurer- Nominations/ Election for new treasurer please Jennifer has been hanging on but would like to do her secretary job.
    - i. Nomination and election for Michelle Barnes as new Treasurer
      1. Motion by Renee, Seconded by Bridget, all in favor
      2. Michelle will be placed on the checking account to sign and write checks.
      3. Missy Posey will be removed from the bank account and as Secretary as Jennifer Gumberavic has taken over this office.
  - b. Summer band/Band Camp-
    - i. Schedules- Monday through Friday 3-9 this includes for the color guard.
    - ii. Rules-

      1. Cost is \$100.00

    - iv. Fees, Payments, \$
      1. Cost is \$400.00/student and \$100/Chaperones

    - v. Uniforms

  - e. Picture day, photos, Football program, etc.
    - i. Pictures will be taken at the school instead of Jackson Mills due to carrying the uniforms and the hot weather. The photographer will be here at 5pm on Aug 1<sup>st</sup>. We will do groups, sections and individual.

- g. Other
